PRESENTATION

You have registered for the 47th INHIGEO Congress, to be held in Les Eyzies (France) from September 16th to September 21st, and/or for the pre- or post-conference field trips, of September 15th to 16th and 21st (evening) to 24th, respectively. Some of you will also follow the sessions online, either live or delayed. PRACTICAL INFORMATION

TALKS

Presentation slots are set at 30 minutes, but preferably include 5 to 10 minutes for questions and discussion. Therefore, please allow 20 to 25 minutes for your talk. You can use power-point (ppt, pptx) and pdf files, which will be projected on a screen, without any format constraints, but with a preference for a landscape orientation. Files shall be communicated on a USB key before the session in which your presentation is scheduled. If you have documents in a special format (videos...), please let us know.

POSTERS

The posters will be displayed throughout the congress. Their size can reach A0 format, at most, in portrait orientation. For those of you who will participate remotely and present a poster, we can either print the poster for you, for a fee corresponding to the cost of printing, or insert your poster as a pdf file in the USB key that will be distributed to participants. If one of these options is of interest to you, please contact us before September 10th (france2022@inhigeo.com).

REMOTE PARTICIPATION

Oral sessions will be streamed live for free. Let us know your interest soon (france2022@inhigeo.com), and we will send you the links and information a few days before. The talks will also be recorded and, subject to the speakers' agreement, can be downloaded later, together with the digital material of the Congress (abstracts, field guidebooks, etc.).
